PETER PILOTTO last night staged an intervention at the Wallace Collection in London. The design duo - Peter Pilotto and Christopher De Vos - rejoined forces with artists Carla Arocha and Stephane Schraenen to showcase their spring/summer 2011 collaboration in the form of a gold mirrored art installation, which took pride of place in the Collection's Grand Gallery.

"I think our work fits well together, it plays with images and is related to pattern and space," said Pilotto, who was joined by model Edie Campbell dressed in an elegant white spring/summer 2011 creation for the celebratory event. "She looks incredible. It's one of our favourite designs and it's great to see it out of context," said De Vos.

And from spring/summer 2011 to autumn/winter 2011-12 and their London Fashion Week show, which takes place on Monday morning.

"We're excited about next season. There is a change of mood to the collection, there is tension in the air, it has a tougher edge. It's very us with a new angle," the designers told us.
